#### Summer Program Program Overview

Location	KidsPLAY and Youth Bound are located at the Eliot Elementary School Cafeteria at 1298 State Road. We will also utilize the Eliot Recreation Department's facilities and our local parks.
Hours of Operation	Monday-Thursday 7:00am-5:30pm Friday 7:00am-4:30pm *Camp activities begin at 9:00 am *Camp activities end at 4:00 pm Please arrive by 8:45am for field trip days as we are not always able to wait for a child/youth that has not arrived by this time. Occasionally, activities or trips will begin or end after the regular 9:00- 4:00 time; please check your schedule. We will be departing for most trips at 9:00am and arriving back from trips by 4:00pm.
Structure	KidsPLAY and Youth Bound will travel off-site two-three days per week. They will remain on- site during inclement weather that would interfere with regular trip plans. Please refer to the calendar of events.
Registration Procedures & Fee Structure	
How To Register	Online registration and In-person (by appointment) registration are available. The calendar is released in April.
Enrollment Forms	An individual enrollment form must be completed for every child that participates in the Summer Program. <b>Please fill out one form per child.</b> It contains important information about your child that we may need over the summer. The information contained in the enrollment form is the property of the Town of Eliot and will be kept in relative confidentiality: information will only be available to the Program's Staff and, in the event of emergency, medical personnel. There is also a Consent Form that also needs to be filled out. This form requires initials after each policy statement.
Fees	<ul> <li>KidsPLAY and Youth Bound Camp Fee:</li> <li>Registration fee: \$25.00</li> <li>\$235.00/week</li> <li>Checks should be made payable to Town of Eliot</li> </ul>
Payment Options	Payments may be made in Full or Weekly. Weekly payments must be made the Thursday prior to the ensuing week. The first weekly payment is due by June 1 <sup>st</sup> . Last weeks' payment is due August 1 <sup>st</sup> .
	After June 1st <sup>h</sup> you are locked in to your schedule <i>and</i> your payment total. Any changes must be made prior to this date. We do not allow for the switching of days. Please do you best to know your schedule at the time of registration.
